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### Vicarage, South Benfleet (Essex)

New vicarage for the Revd H.R. Lloyd.

S: RIBA plans and sections (3) Godfrey index records an early perspective of South Benfleet vicarage which was rejected by the Royal Academy (Fig. 2).

### Oakfield, Smart's Hill, Penshurst (Kent)

Unidentified work for the Revd George Richard Boissier.

Mrs Boissier sold Oakfield after her husband died in 1856 and moved to The Grove. It has now been altered and enlarged.

Village and estate improvements for Philip Charles Sidney, 1st Baron De L'Isle and Dudley, and after 1851 for Sir Philip Sidney, 2nd Lord De L'Isle and Dudley, Leinster Square

Two new cottages were added to the range framing the entrance to the cloister.

Gateway Lodge

Signed *Thomas Barber February 1850*. Sketch of coat of arms and fleur-de-lis. Barber is not recorded as a builder in the neighbourhood of Penshurst.

### House for a Doctor

Preliminary designs for an unidentified house.

S: RIBA plans and elevations (5).

Two alternative schemes were prepared in the Italian villa and Tudor styles. The house was to have the usual middle class accommodation, a surgery, consulting and waiting rooms. A note refers to a *site adjoining Toll Bar*.

### South Park, Penshurst (Kent)

Estate work for Lieut. Gen. Sir Henry Hardinge, later 1st Viscount Hardinge.

### Chafford Arms, Fordcombe (Kent)

New public house for Lieut. Gen. Hardinge.

It had a kitchen, taproom, bar and parlour, four bedrooms, a dressing room above; there were stables and a detached brew-house containing a bread oven and two coppers; the builder was Henry Constable.

### Cottage for Miss Yates

Design for a cottage, possibly to be built at The Birches, Penshurst.
